Beloved friends in mission:

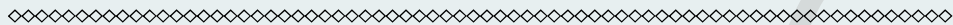

At the present time, we are working with the newly elected leadership of the Evangelical Lutheran Church of Colombia in developing our Annual Plan for 2026 and a new strategic plan for the years 2026-2030.

We share our 2025 Annual Report with heartfelt gratitude and joy. Our gratitude to you for making it possible ongoing stories of hope, resilience, leadership and sustainable futures here in Colombia!

*** Formal Education Scholarship Program:** 283 students, ranging from elementary school to university, achieved their formal education goals. Of this number, 39 elementary and high school students graduated. 2 female university students graduated with professional degrees as an Accountant and as a Lawyer.

*** Training Seminars on Life Skills:** 14 university students and their parents engaged in training seminars on self-knowledge, emotional intelligence, assertive communication, interpersonal relationships and decision making. These seminars strengthened leadership skills, one of our new logo's core values.

*** Support to Ministries of the Evangelical Lutheran Church of Colombia:** as Foundation of the Evangelical Lutheran Church of Colombia, we work jointly and strategically to maximize and multiply resources. This year 2025, the ripple effects of your generosity blessed the National Evangelism Ministry, National Senior Ministry and the Annual Youth Ministry Retreat. At this Retreat, Fundacion Camino de Emaus led a leadership seminar with 103 youths in attendance. In support of the National Ministry of Education, financial resources blessed the CELCO Lutheran School in El Cocuy and the National Sunday School Teachers Retreat.

*** Children's Protection Policy:** Working collaboratively with key leadership of the Evangelical Lutheran Church of Colombia, our Children's Protection Policy was updated and will be ready next year to continue its implementation throughout the Evangelical Lutheran Church of Colombia and the CELCO Lutheran Schools.

*** Bilingual Communication - Good Shepherd Senior Center.** Thanks to the generosity of the Synod of Alberta & the Territories of the Evangelical Lutheran Church of Canada, 40 vulnerable seniors in Soacha enjoy holistic services such as nutrition, recreation, home visits and spiritual accompaniment. Fundacion Camino de Emaus facilitates bilingual communication between the Lutheran Church of Colombia, the USA and Canada.



*** Global Voices Celebration:** This virtual celebration brings together voices from Colombia, the United States and Canada. Through music, prayer, testimonials and storytelling, together we uplift and amplify the transformative power of mission relationship and generosity.



*** Growing National Generosity:** October is the month when our National Campaign “Ora y Colabora” (Pray & Give Campaign) takes place. The goal is to socialize the work of the Foundation and invite generosity from congregations, former scholarship recipients, organizations and friends in Colombia. Thanks to the generosity of this campaign, 17 elementary school students will be blessed with scholarships in 2026.

*** Casa Emaus:** Located at the headquarters of the Lutheran Church of Colombia, Casa Emaus serves as welcoming home and place of hospitality for national and international groups. Casa Emaus is a shared project between the Lutheran Church of Colombia and Fundacion Camino de Emaus. Revenues from Casa Emaus further support our shared ministries.

*** Endowment for Formal Education in Colombia:** We are grateful to IELCO-Finland Scholarship Program for its foundational gifts to this growing endowment in Colombia. Thanks to this endowment, 5 students who are living in the countryside are being blessed with scholarships. We are passionate and committed to further growing the seeds of sustainability of this endowment.

*** LIZWAN Endowment in the USA:** Thanks to the generosity of the Lizarazo Wangsness and the Okerson families, this growing endowment ensures long term sustainability for the holistic mission of Fundacion Camino de Emaus.
